Social Identity - its impact -

Effects on the out-group

- 1) Perception of homogeneity
 - the cross-race identification bias
 - musical preferences
- 2) Unfavorable biases
- 3) Unfavorable attributions
- 4) Discrimination towards the in-group

Social Identity - its impact -

When a threat/disadvantage is perceived

- 1) Increase in the negative prejudices targeting important group values
 - Lazyness & lack of ambition/intelligence vs lack of friendliness/cooperativeness
- 2) Increase in the intergroup discrimination

Social Identity - its impact -

When a threat/disadvantage is perceived

- 3) When facing the threat : the preventive attack
 - Glorification of the in-group values, preventive attack and self-justification
 - Ex : Democracy and terrorism
- 4) The moral exclusion : a self-justified dehumanization
